



Heptacodium miconoides

The common name, Seven-son flower, comes from Hepta- meaning "seven," and -codium referring to the flower head- typically seven-part flower clusters that make up the inflorescence.

Heptacodium miconioides is a large, fountain-shaped, multi-stemmed, deciduous shrub that typically grows 15-20' at maturity with a 10' spread but may also be trained as a single-trunk tree. During early May, distinct three-veined, glossy **leaves** emerge and remain attractive all season and are retained into early winter.

In late summer, at a time when few other woody plants are in bloom, creamy white, jasmine-like **blossoms** emerge from the tips of the branches. Flowers are sweetly fragrant, persist for several weeks and are good source of nectar for butterflies and other insect pollinators.

In fall, flowers are followed by equally showy (if not showier) rose-pink **calyces** which elongate after bloom and last into late fall resulting in a spectacular, eye-catching display. These calyces crown inconspicuous, purplish-red, 1/2" fruits.

Winter interest is provided by tan **bark** that exfoliates to reveal attractive brown inner bark.

Observed plants have proven to be **cold hardy** to temperatures as low as minus 30 degrees below zero while still maintaining superior flower and fruit displays and have **no serious insect or disease problems**.

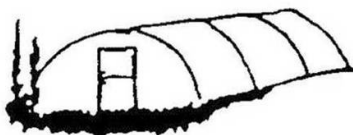

(Zone 4) Similar in form and color to *Abies fraseri*, but more site tolerant. Grows 40-55' in height with a spread of 20-25'.

Acer griseum

(Zone 5) Commonly called paper bark maple, *griseum* is a small, deciduous, oval to oval-rounded tree with slender upright branching. It is particularly noted for its exfoliating copper orange to cinnamon reddish/brown bark and its showy orange to red fall color. It typically matures to 20-30' tall.

Acer palmatum 'Atropurpureum'

A small, deciduous tree with delicate, upright branches, reaching a height and spread of about 20', forming a vase shaped specimen tree.

Buddleia x weyeriana 'Honeycomb'

(Zone 5) A yellow-flowered butterfly bush that typically grows to 5-7' tall and 4-5' wide with an upright-arching to spreading habit. If not pruned back each year, it will grow taller. It is a hybrid (B. davidii var. magnifica x B. globosa) that is noted for producing yellow flowers with orange eyes in globe-shaped panicles. In comparison to B. davidii forms, this hybrid produces stronger branching that is less likely to sprawl, but smaller, fragrant flower panicles clumped at the stem ends rather than in long pyramidal clusters.
